

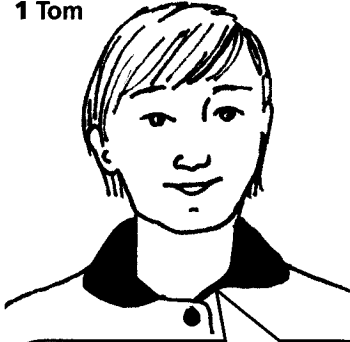
# 1 Money, money, money

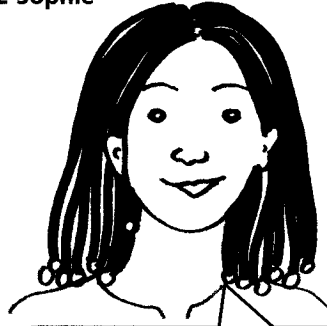
1 Read the information about Tom, Sophie and Leo who live in Manchester.
